**5. PARENTAL ACCESS TO RECORDS AND INFORMATION:** Under Arizona law, both parents are entitled to have equal access to documents and other information concerning the child(ren)'s education and physical, mental, moral and emotional health including medical, school, police, court and other records. A person who does not comply with a reasonable request for these records shall reimburse the requesting parent for court costs and attorney fees incurred by that parent to make the other parent obey this request. A parent who attempts to restrict the release of documents or information by the custodian of the records without a prior court order is subject to legal sanctions.

**6. EDUCATIONAL ARRANGEMENTS:**

- Both parents have the right to participate in school conferences, events and activities, and the right to consult with teachers and other school personnel.
- Both parents will make major educational decisions together. If both parents do not agree regarding the educational decisions, then:
- If the parents do not agree, then the final decision making regarding educational decisions shall be with  mother  father after consultation with the other parent.

**7. MEDICAL AND DENTAL ARRANGEMENTS:**

- Both parents have the right to authorize emergency medical treatment, if needed, and the right to consult with physicians and other medical practitioners. Both parents agree to advise the other parent immediately of any emergency medical/dental care sought for the child(ren), to cooperate on health matters concerning the child(ren) and to keep one another reasonably informed. Both parents agree to keep each other informed as to names, addresses and telephone numbers of all medical/dental care providers.

- ASK OTHER PARENT IF HE OR SHE WANTS TO TAKE CARE OF CHILD(REN).** Each parent agrees to consider the other parent as care-provider for the child(ren) before making other arrangements.
- RELOCATION OF CHILD.** Under Arizona law (ARS §25-408) if by written agreement or court order, both parents are entitled to Joint Legal Decision-Making or parenting time and both parents reside in the state, at least 45 days' advance written notice shall be provided to the other parent before a parent may do either of the following:
  1. Relocate the child outside the state.
  2. Relocate the child more than 100 miles within the state.
 Under Arizona law (ARS §25-403.01 C) an order for sole legal decision-making does not allow the parent designated as sole legal decision-maker to alter unilaterally a court-ordered parenting time plan.
- PERSONAL CARE ARRANGEMENTS.**
  - Each parent may during his/her scheduled parenting time, make routine personal care decisions for our children.

- [ ] **COMMUNICATE.** Each parent agrees that all communications regarding the child(ren) will be between the parents and that they will not use the child(ren) to convey information or to set up parenting time changes.

- [ ] **PARENTING PLAN.** Both parents agree that if either parent moves out of the area and returns later, they will use the most recent Parenting Plan/Access Agreement before the move or the minimum Yavapai County Access Guidelines until other arrangements can be worked out.
- NOTIFY OTHER PARENT OF PROBLEMS WITH TIME-SHARING AHEAD OF TIME.** If either parent is unable to follow through with the timesharing arrangements involving the child(ren), that parent will notify the other parent as soon as possible.
- CONCILIATION/MEDIATION.** If the parents wish to make a legal change to the existing court ordered Parenting Plan, they will try to work out a new Parenting Plan with a private mediator before starting any court action.
- DO NOT DEVIATE FROM PLAN UNTIL DISPUTE IS RESOLVED.** Both parents are advised that while a dispute is being resolved, neither parent shall deviate from this Parenting Plan, or act in such a way that is inconsistent with the terms of this agreement.
- [ ] **REVIEW.** The parents agree to review the terms of their joint legal decision-making agreement and make any necessary or desired changes every \_\_\_\_\_ months from the date of this document.
